Educational Empowerment to the girls of KGBV School by NTPC Ramagundam

NTPC Ramagundam under CSR-CD has always provided sustainable livelihood opportunities to its youth who belong from underprivileged families & communities around its Project affected Villages, Considering the lack of exposure in the communities around Ramagundam locations, NTPC Ramagundam under CSR-CD has ventured into the space of skill development to develop and enhance skills of Local youth and provide them employment opportunities.

In line with the same NTPC Ramagundam under CSR-CD in coloration with Central Institute of Plastic Engineering and technology is coming up with Diploma in Plastic Technology (DPT) Long term residential course for two years comprising of 4 semesters in which ten students have been identified from Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya Kundanapally.

To motivate the girls Shri Sunil Kumar, CGM (Ramagundam & Telangana) interacted with the selected candidates and motivated them by saying that this is just the beginning for you all and one should always have a learning attitude which will eventually lead you the success. He further added that in this two-year diploma program you must regularly acquire skills and sincerely apply it in your work.

He further added that after the completion of this two-year diploma course, you all will be self-made person and in the plastic industry there is a huge shortage of manpower, so this is a golden opportunity for you all to acquire skills and do wonders, adding to it, Shri Sunil Kumar CGM (R&T) said after these initiatives more other avenues will be opened by NTPC Ramagundam for empowering women and enhancing the skills of local youth.

Sharing her view on this occasion, Smt Vijaya Lakshmi Murlidharan, AGM-HR NTPC Ramagundam said, that Education is the turning point of women empowerment because it enables them to respond to the challenges, to confront their traditional role, and to change their life.

She further added that NTPC Ramagundam will come up with many more initiatives in the future for empowering the girls of the project-affected villages by educating them and quoted that “ If you educate a man, you educate an individual but if you educate a woman, you educate a nation”.

Republic Day-2022 Celebrated with Patriotism at NTPC-Ramagundam

73rd Republic Day was celebrated at NTPC-Ramagundam with patriotism on January 26, 2022. At a project-level programme held at M. G. Stadium, Chief Guest of the occasion Shri Sunil Kumar, CGM (Ramagundam & Telangana) hoisted the tricolour and took the salute at the march-past parade by CISF.

Addressing the gathering, Shri Sunil Kumar spoke on the significance of Republic Day besides highlighting the glorious history of NTPC and its contribution to the development of the country.

He highlighted the success story of NTPC-Ramagundam with emphasis on plant performance. NTPC-Ramagundam is moving ahead to achieve its annual target in FY 2021-22 despite Covid disruption. Till 31st December 2021, Ramagundam generated 13079 MUs at PLF of 76.22% against MoU target of 12012 MUs and PLF of 70%. He further added that because of collective efforts in 2021, NTPC Ramagundam has achieved key milestones, reaffirming our leadership position in the industry. With a capacity of 37.5 MW, India's largest floating solar PV project has been declared commercial in 2021.

The increase in efficiency due to the new turbine will reduce annual CO2 emission by 53000 MT and congratulated the team for achieving 210 MW load in U3.

He further added that NTPC-Ramagundam is taking concerted efforts in enriching the environment with commitment and has released the WATER & Biodiversity Conservation plan 2022 and 2032. Towards actualising NTPC's corporate plan, Ramagundam Super Thermal Power Station is moving ahead with its all-around performance.

Speaking on the progress of **Telangana Stage-I (2x800 MW)**, Shri Sunil Kumar said that construction activities are going on in full swing and expecting completion by March 2022. This will give momentum to the development of Telangana as the home State will get maximum power from it. **Further tapping the solar potential, NTPC-Ramagundam's 100 MW Floating Solar PV Project in its reservoir covering 450 acres water surface area has been declared India's largest floating solar PV project and commercial in 2021.**

On this occasion, Shri Sunil Kumar along with other dignitaries presented CISF parade trophies. However, Business Unit Head (BUH) Meritorious And Safety Awards to NTPC employees for their excellent performances were announced.

Shri Avinash Saraswat, GM (FGD); Shri Prasenjit Pal, GM (Project); Dr E.R Murthy, CMO and Smt Vijayalakshmi Muralidharan, AGM (HR) were present on the occasion. HODs, office bearers of Unions & associations, CISF officials and NTPC employees were part of the occasion while following the Covid-19 Protocol.



Medical Camp organized by CSR- CD for young girls

NTPC RAMAGUNDAM in association with NTPC Dhanvantri Hospital on 9th, March 2022 started medical camp for the selection of 120 girls for a month-long Girl residential workshop .

Medical Test for a total of 209 girl students of class V class covering 26 neighbouring schools will be conducted from 9th-14th, March 2022.

On the first day of the medical test total 65 girl students, covering 5 schools of the Project affected villages were examined.

The costs towards organizing the camp will be borne by NTPC for 120 Girls students.

This unique initiative will give a good learning opportunity to the girl students as they would be exposed to new and modern concepts of learning.

The children will be taught about ways to conserve environment, health and hygiene, besides lessons in English, Hindi, Maths and Science.

Around 10 per cent of the best performing students would get an opportunity to pursue further studies in the best of NTPC township schools free of cost till class 12th class.

The medical camp was successfully conducted under the guidance of Smt. Vijaya Lakshmi Muralidharan AGM- HR, Dr Madhu Singh AGM Medical, and Shri DS kumar DGM-HR .

Interaction with Print & Electronic Media Representatives

NTPC Ramagundam organised Interaction with Print & Electronic Media Representatives on 25th March 2021. Chief Guest of the occasion Shri Sunil Kumar, CGM (Ramagundam & Telangana) along with senior officials interacted and replied to queries from reporters. In addition to this, after successful commissioning, third part capacity of 80 MW out of 100 MW Floating Solar PV Project at Ramagundam, Telangana, has been declared on Commercial Operation with effect from 24.03.2022. Each block consists of one floating platform and an array of approx. 11,200 solar modules. The floating platform consists of one Inverter, Transformer, and a HT breaker. The solar modules are placed on floaters manufactured with HDPE (High Density Polyethylene) material. The entire floating system is being anchored through special HMPE (High Modulus Polyethylene) rope to the dead weights placed in the balancing reservoir bed. The power is being evacuated up to the existing switch yard through 33KV underground cables. The 100 MW Ramagundam floating solar PV project is due for completion in the next few months. More than 20 reporters from different news channels & newspapers attended the programme.

Speaking on the occasion, on achieving the milestone Shri Sunil Kumar lauded the efforts of the team and applauded NTPC Ramagundam for being at the forefront of renewable energy. He highlighted the achievements of Ramagundam so far in the current financial year as well as the progress of Telangana Project, 100 MW Floating Solar and Environment Management, etc. During this occasion, Shri Anil Kumar Vemula, GM (R&E); and Smt Vijaya Lakshmi M, Head of HR were present on the occasion. Following the interaction, a media visit to the 100 MW solar PV project took place.
